**Today** – Another relatively quiet day is expected in Springfield, however there will be notable increase in cloud cover as the day progresses. In fact, a 10% chance for a brief/light shower or sprinkles will be mentioned after 3pm. Otherwise, dry conditions will persist with temperatures reaching the lower 80s. Winds will again be light and could become erratic during the afternoon.

**Extended forecast** – A slow moving upper-level disturbance will meander over the region tonight through Monday. This should allow areas of intermittent showers to develop late tonight and then persist at times through the day Sunday. T-storms will also become possible, but this will be mainly after 2pm Sunday afternoon. A threat, for a shower/T-storm should persist into Monday however chances are lower than Sunday.
