Extended Forecast – The remnants of Francine will continue to impact western and central portions of TN with multiple rounds of showers and tstorms through the extended forecast. The greatest chances of seeing activity will be overnight tonight through the day tomorrow. Overnight lows will be in the 60s with daytime highs in the upper 70s to lower 80s. Winds are expected to remain relatively light with gusts only to 15 mph tomorrow with even less wind expected the other days of the extended forecast. Total rainfall amounts for the entire event will likely remain under 2".
