- Warm dry year with just ½" of rain from May 1 to June 15 (2" below average).
- Malloy earned CGCS (Certified Golf Course Superintendent) status in 2023.
- The maintenance department was named the TPC maintenance operation of the year in 2023.
- The Ascendant was tabbed the Korn Ferry Tour event of the year in 2023.
- There is a Heron Sanctuary in the reservoirs that border the course.
