Today – A mix of sun and clouds to partly cloudy skies are forecast throughout the day. A sea breeze boundary may develop near the course this afternoon – allowing for an isolated coverage of pop-up showers. A brief heavy shower cannot be ruled out this afternoon. Winds will remain rather light as temperatures climb into the low 80s for an afternoon high. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10". Sunrise: 6:48am / Sunset: 5:37pm

Extended forecast – A cold front will approach the Central Bahamas in a weakened state overnight and is expected to produce a widely scattered coverage of intermittent quick-moving rain bands after 10pm. This activity will remain possible Monday morning before the frontal boundary lifts back to the north for Monday afternoon. Dry conditions are likely to occur on Tuesday ahead of another weakening cold front that will return isolated shower chances on Wednesday.
