**Today** – Mostly sunny to start the day becoming a mix of sun and clouds this afternoon. Any patches of fog across the front 9 holes of the course are expected to dissipate between 7-8am. Light westerly winds this morning will turn northerly out ahead of a weakening cold front. This weakening boundary will bring isolated shower chances for the afternoon and evening hours. The temperature will peak near 82°F.

**Tomorrow** – Anticipate a mix of sun and clouds to start the day on Thursday becoming partly cloudy by late morning. A few passing showers are possible through mid-morning prior to a weak frontal boundary lifting north of the Central Bahamas. Winds will be east-southeasterly at 7-14 mph along with gusts of 15-18 mph. The temperature is forecast to reach a high in the low 80s.
