Today - A broken line of thunderstorms is expected to move through the area between 9:30am-12:30pm this morning. Lightning, moderate to heavy rain, and wind gusts of $35-50 \mathrm{mph}$ all possible in these storms. Once storms exit the area, expecting mostly dry conditions for the afternoon, although a low chance for a very isolated pop-up storm cannot be ruled out. Winds will initially be breezy out of the SSE, turning to S with gusts of $30-38 \mathrm{mph}$ possible during much of the day.

Extended Forecast - Mostly dry tonight through the early afternoon on Saturday. There remains a chance for some afternoon storms, mainly after 4 pm , but these chances will be low. Coverage will likely remain conditional but any cells that can develop will pose a threat for severe criteria conditions and heavy rainfall accumulations. Rain chances pick up after dark, with higher confidence in storms moving through during the early AM hours Sunday. Conditions expected to clear out by late morning with low chances for isolated storms in the afternoon. A slight chance of tstorms will hold into early next week as well. Saturday is still expected to be the windiest day of the tournament, with gusts of up to 40-45 mph likely. Winds stay elevated to 30-35 Sunday morning, lessening to $20-25 \mathrm{mph}$ by mid-afternoon.
