Extended Forecast – Widespread thunderstorms expected to begin pre-sunrise Sunday morning, with the highest chances continuing through 9-10am. Confidence remains on the lower side for the exit time of storms Sunday morning as it will depend where the front ends up stalling out. If the front stalls just to the east, some dry periods can be expected during the afternoon. If the front stalls over the course, higher rainfall totals of up to 2"+ cannot be ruled out. Winds stay elevated to 26-30 Sunday morning, lessening to 20-25 mph by mid-afternoon.
