Today – Patchy fog has been able to develop but coverage will remain limited over the next hour before conditions erode near 730AM. A complex of strong storms continues to develop well to the west of the area and will traverse the KY/TN border through the day on approach to the course this PM. Onset of storms in the area could be as early as 2PM but more likely into the 3-5PM timeframe. Strong storms remain possible as this activity pushes in. SW'ly winds will enhance later into the day.

Monday – Strong thunderstorms along a cold front are likely to be ongoing in the area at the start of Monday, with some locally strong/severe activity possible. This front will begin to slow in progression through the morning hours allowing storms to persist in the area through mid-day. As the frontal boundary pushes southeast, some lingering showers/t-storms are possible before clearing conditions take over later into the PM hours.
