Thomas Detry (1st/-9)

- With a career-high 10 birdies, cards career-low round on TOUR with a 9-under 63 at Spyglass (previous: 64/five times)
- Holds first 18-hole lead/co-lead and second lead after any round on TOUR (T1/R2/2022 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- With rounds of 71-69-73-69, finished T37 in 2023 in his only prior appearance at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Best finish in 44 prior PGA TOUR starts is solo-second at the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship
- Making third start of the season (MC/The American Express, T20/Farmers Insurance Open)
- Qualified for the event by finishing No. 63 in the 2022-23 FedExCup Fall and Eligibility Points List (field filled to 80 players using that list)
- Is one of 17 players in the field that have not qualified for The Genesis Invitational; with a win, would be eligible for the six remaining Signature Events this season

Patrick Cantlay (2nd/-8)

- 8-under 64 is his lowest score in seven rounds at Spyglass Hill Golf Course (previous: 66/R1/2020)
- Second opening-round 64 (-8) of the season (The American Express/La Quinta Country Club/T52)
- Has three top-10s (T9/2013, T3/2021, T4/2022) in six previous starts at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am

Miscellaneous Notes

- The AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am is the second Signature Event of the 2024 PGA TOUR Season and only Signature Event that has a set field size (due to the pro-am format); the event features nocut and is played on two courses (Pebble Beach Golf Links and Spyglass Hill Golf Course), with the pro-am portion concluding on Friday
- Last week's winner of the Farmers Insurance Open, **Matthieu Pavon** (3rd/-7) seeks to become the first player to earn his first two wins in consecutive events on the TOUR schedule since David Duval in 1997 (Michelob Championship at Kingsmill, Walt Disney World/Oldsmobile Classic)
- Defending champion **Justin Rose** (T8/-4) seeks to become the first player to successfully defend a title at the event since Dustin Johnson in 2010 and first on TOUR since Tom Kim (2023 Shriners Children's Open)
- World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T14/-3) is one of 11 players in the field making their tournament debut; his best finish in a tournament debut on TOUR: 2nd/2021 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
- Making his season debut, three-time FedExCup Champion and 24-time PGA TOUR winner Rory McIlroy (T39/-1) was
 assessed a two-stroke penalty after his drop on the par-5 seventh hole at Spyglass (Rule 19.2b / Back-on-the-Line Relief);
 has won three in his career when making his season debut, both coming at THE CJ CUP (2021, 2022)
- At 11-under, Patrick Cantlay/Egon Durban and Thomas Detry/Rich Petit lead the Pro-Am portion of the competition
- First-round scoring averages: Pebble Beach Golf Links (71.000), Spyglass Hill Golf Course (70.325)
- Due to forecasted moderate rain, preferred lies are in effect during the first two rounds
