Scottie Scheffler (T1/-11)

- 11th career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR, the most of any player since joining the TOUR at the start of the 2019-20 season; 2-for-10 to date (wins: 2022 Masters Tournament, 2023 WM Phoenix Open)
Most 36-hole leads/co-leads on TOUR since the start of the 2019-20 season

- 8-under 64 is the low round of the week at Pebble Beach
- Making his tournament debut at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (missed the cut at the 2019 U.S. Open at Pebble Beach); one of 11 players in the field making tournament debut
- Leads the PGA TOUR with six wins since the start of the 2021-22 season (5: Rory McIlroy, Jon Rahm)
- Best finish in a tournament debut on TOUR: 2nd, 2021 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play

Ludvig Åberg (T1/-11)

- Second career 36-hole lead/co-lead and first since the 2023 RSM Classic (went on to win); also stood 11-under through 36 holes at The RSM Classic (also played on two courses)
- Making his tournament debut at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am; one of 11 players in the field making tournament debut
- With a win, would tie Lucas Glover and Viktor Hovland for most wins (2) since joining the TOUR at the 2023 RBC Canadian Open
- With a win, would become the second European to win the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (Justin Rose became the first in 2023)
- Qualified for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational via the Aon Next 10 (Nos. 51-60 in the FedExCup Fall and Eligibility Points List)

Thomas Detry (T1/-11)

- Second career 36-hole lead/co-lead and first since the 2022 Sanderson Farms Championship (finished T9)
- Second consecutive week playing in the final group during the third round (T3 through 36 holes at last week's Farmers Insurance Open; finished T20)
- With a win, would become the second European to win the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (Justin Rose became the first in 2023)
- With rounds of 71-69-73-69, finished T37 in 2023 in his only prior appearance at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Best finish in 44 prior PGA TOUR starts is solo-second at the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship
- Making third start of the season (MC/The American Express, T20/Farmers Insurance Open)
- Qualified for the event by finishing No. 63 in the 2022-23 FedExCup Fall and Eligibility Points List (field filled to 80 players using that list)

- One of 17 players in the field that have not qualified for The Genesis Invitational; with a win, would be eligible for the six remaining Signature Events this season

Miscellaneous Notes

- Last week's winner of the Farmers Insurance Open, **Matthieu Pavon** (T5/-9), seeks to become the first player to earn his first two wins in consecutive events on the TOUR schedule since David Duval in 1997 (Michelob Championship at Kingsmill, Walt Disney World/Oldsmobile Classic); Pavon is the only player at T8 or better that played Spyglass Hill in the second round
- This is the second tournament this season that there have been three or more players tied for the lead through 36 holes (Sony Open in Hawaii); there were three such tournaments during the 2022-23 season (2022 RSM Classic, 2023 Wells Fargo Championship, 2023 PGA Championship)
- At 17-under, **Rory McIlroy** and **Jeff Rhodes** (TPG Capital) win the pro-am portion of the event by one stroke over Matt Fitzpatrick/George Still, Matthieu Pavon/Pascal Grizot and Patrick Cantlay/Egon Durban
- Due to forecasted moderate rain, preferred lies were in effect during the first two rounds
- The AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am is the second Signature Event of the 2024 PGA TOUR Season and only Signature Event that has a set field size (80 players due to the pro-am format); the event features no cut and is played on two courses (Pebble Beach Golf Links and Spyglass Hill Golf Course), with the pro-am portion concluding on Friday
