TOUR season notes

- There are just four events (three weeks) remaining in the FedExCup Regular Season, and new in 2023, only the top 70 players at the conclusion of the Wyndham Championship will qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs. 26 players in the field have a chance to move into the top 70 in the FedExCup standings with a win (all players currently at No. 129 or higher in the standings)
- Players in the field who are currently on the bubble for the top 70 include **Mark Hubbard** (No. 61), **Luke List** (No. 68), 2018 champion **Andrew Putnam** (No. 72) and **Adam Svensson** (No. 77)
- 24 players in the field at the Barracuda Championship competed at last week's Genesis Scottish Open, including four that made the cut: **Max Greyserman** (T21), **Maximilian Kieffer** (T21), **Charley Hoffman** (T57), **Sam Stevens** (T57)
- 110 players in the field at the Barracuda Championship competed at last week's ISCO Championship, with seven players finishing T6 or better: **Zac Blair** (T2), **Rico Hoey** (T2), **Matt NeSmith** (T2), **Sam Bairstow** (T6), **S.Y. Noh** (T6), **Neal Shipley** (T6), **Ben Taylor** (T6)

Barracuda Championship notes

- There are three past champions of the Barracuda Championship in the field: **Scott Piercy** (2011), **Andrew Putnam** (2018), **Chez Reavie** (2022)
- Seven of the last eight winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners: 2016/Greg Chalmers, 2017/Chris Stroud, 2018/Andrew Putnam, 2019/Collin Morikawa, 2020/Richy Werenski, 2021/Erik van Rooyen, Akshay Bhatia/2023
- As part of the Strategic Alliance between the PGA TOUR and the DP World Tour, the Barracuda Championship features a field of 156 players including 50 players from the DP World Tour with the winner receiving benefits on each Tour:
 - FedExCup points: 300
 - DP World Tour Rankings points: 500
 - PGA TOUR exemption (for current PGA TOUR members): thru 2026
 - PGA TOUR exemption (for non-members): thru 2025
 - DP World Tour exemption: thru 2026
- New in 2024, the tournament has elected to switch the nines at Old Greenwood; with two par 5s (Nos. 11 and 15) and a drivable par-4 (No. 17) on the tournament's closing stretch.
- Since 2012, the Barracuda Championship has been played using Modified Stableford scoring. The scoring system allocates points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole, with the goal of achieving the highest overall number of points.
Modified Stableford scoring:
Double eagle: +8 points
Eagle: +5 points
Birdie: +2 points
Par: 0 points
Bogey: -1 point
Double bogey or worse: -3 points

Top player notes

- Four PGA TOUR winners during the 2024 season are in the field this week: **Nick Dunlap** (The American Express), **Jake Knapp** (Mexico Open at Vidanta), **Peter Malnati** (Valspar Championship) and **Taylor Pendrith** (THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- At No. 36 in the FedExCup, **Taylor Pendrith** holds the highest position of any player in the field. Pendrith has a pair of top-10s at the Barracuda Championship in three starts at the event (T13/2021, T11/2022) and has four top-10s on TOUR this season
- The field includes 43 players who have won on the PGA TOUR, led by 2012 FedExCup Champion **Brandt Snedeker** with nine
