Scoring

The Barracuda Championship utilizes the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Ben Silverman (1st/+19)

- Holds the lead for the first time after any round on the PGA TOUR (previous best: T2 after 18 holes of the 2019 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)
- Best finish in 81 starts on TOUR: T7/2017 Sanderson Farms Championship
- Best finish in 19 starts on TOUR this season: T13/Mexico Open at Vidanta
- Seven of the last eight winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners (Chez Reavie/2023)
- Making third start at the Barracuda Championship: T11/2018, MC/2019
- Currently No. 100 in the FedExCup standings as he seeks to advance to the FedExCup Playoffs for the first time (top 70 players following the Wyndham Championship advance to the Playoffs)
- In his third season on the PGA TOUR after finishing No. 5 in the Korn Ferry Tour Points List in 2023; played consecutive seasons on TOUR (2017-18, 2018-19)
- Two-time winner on the Korn Ferry Tour (most recent: 2023 Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club)

Additional Notes

- Kelly Kraft (2nd/+17) enters the week off three consecutive missed cuts with his best result in eight starts this season at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (T11 with partner Kevin Tway); owns three runner-up finishes on TOUR (one each in 2017, 2018 and 2019)
- 2024 American Express winner **Nick Dunlap** (T9/+12) is one of four PGA TOUR winners this season in the field (Jake Knapp/Mexico Open at Vidanta, Peter Malnati/Valspar Championship, Taylor Pendrith/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- Making his fourth start at the Barracuda Championship (best: T11/2022), Canada's **Taylor Pendrith** (T9/+12) is the highest ranked player in the field at No. 36 in the FedExCup standings
- Three past Barracuda Championship winners in the field: **Andrew Putnam**/2018 (T23/+10), **Scott Piercy**/2011 (T49/+7), **Chez Reavie**/2022 (T124/+1)
