Scoring

The Barracuda Championship utilizes the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Mac Meissner (1st/+26)

- The PGA TOUR Rookie seeks his first PGA TOUR win in his debut appearance at the Barracuda Championship
- Holds the lead for the first time after any round on the PGA TOUR (previous best: T12 after 18 holes at the 2024 RBC Canadian Open)
- Best finish in 18 starts on TOUR this season: T5/2024 Charles Schwab Challenge
- Seven of the last eight winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners (Chez Reavie/2023)
- Last rookie winner on TOUR: Jake Knapp/2024 Mexico Open at Vidanta
- Earned membership after finishing 20th on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List; carded three top-10 finishes on the season including T3 at the season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Championship

Additional Notes

- **J.J. Spaun** (2nd/+25) seeks first win since his maiden victory at the 2022 Valero Texas Open in his seventh start at the Barracuda Championship (best: T3/2018)
- Making his fourth start at the Barracuda Championship (best: T11/2022), Canada’s **Taylor Pendrith** (T3/+24) is the highest ranked player in the field at No. 36 in the FedExCup standings; is one of four PGA TOUR winners this season in the field (Nick Dunlap/The American Express, Jake Knapp/Mexico Open at Vidanta, Peter Malnati/Valspar Championship)
- Four-time PGA TOUR winner **Sean O’Hair** (T3/+24) enters the week off two consecutive missed cuts with his best result in seven starts this season at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (37th with partner Ben Taylor)
- Each of the three Barracuda Championship winners in the field made the cut: **Andrew Putnam**/2018 (T42/+15), **Chez Reavie**/2022 (T48/+14), **Scott Piercy**/2011 (T60/+13)
