Scoring

The Barracuda Championship utilizes the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Mac Meissner (1st/+39)

- Seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 19th TOUR start; best career TOUR finish: T5/2024 Charles Schwab Challenge
- Would become the 11th first-time winner of the season on TOUR and third in as many weeks (Davis Thompson/John Deere Classic, Harry Hall/ISCO Championship)
- Seven of the last eight winners of the Barracuda Championship were first-time PGA TOUR winners (Chez Reavie/2023)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the first time (previous best: T26 after 54 holes of the 2024 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Austin Smotherman)
- 14 third-round leaders/co-leaders have won the Barracuda Championship (most recent: Chez Reavie/2022)
- 20 third-round leaders/co-leaders have won in individual stroke-play events on TOUR this season (most recent: Davis Thompson/John Deere Classic)
- +39 sets low 54-hole score since the tournament moved to Tahoe Mountain Club (Old Greenwood) in 2020 (previous: +38/Adam Schenk/2021)
- Would become the first PGA TOUR rookie winner since Jake Knapp at the 2024 Mexico Open at Vidanta
- Would become the first player to win the event in debut appearance since Erik van Rooyen (2021)
- Earned membership after finishing 20th on the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List; carded three top-10 finishes on the season including T3 at the season-ending Korn Ferry Tour Championship

Additional Notes

- Competing this season on a Major Medical Extension, **Vince Whaley** (2nd/+38) is making his third start at this event (MC/2020, T9/2021, T31/2022); best finish in 101 starts on TOUR: T5/2022 ISCO Championship
- Following a runner-up at last week's ISCO Championship, **Rico Hoey** (3rd/+36) seeks to become the first player to lose a playoff one week and win a tournament the next since Patrick Cantlay in 2022 (RBC Heritage/Zurich Classic of New Orleans)

- Making his third PGA TOUR start, South Africa's Casey Jarvis (T6/+33) records an ace on the par-3 sixth hole
- Mats Ege withdrew during the third round due to back injury
