Scoring

The Barracuda Championship utilizes the Modified Stableford scoring format, the first PGA TOUR event to use the format since The International in 2006. Players are allocated points based on the number of strokes taken at each hole with the goal of achieving the highest overall score.

Nick Dunlap (Won/+49)

- Earns his second PGA TOUR title in his 21st start at the age of 20 years, 6 months and 28 days
- First player in history to win on TOUR as an amateur (2024 The American Express) and a professional in the same season
- Becomes the first player since Tom Kim to win twice on the PGA TOUR before turning 21 (2022 Wyndham Championship, 2022 Shriners Children's Open)
- After entering the week at No. 93 in the FedExCup standings, moves to No. 63; the top 70 players following the Wyndham Championship advancing to the FedExCup Playoffs
- Earns 500 DP World Tour Rankings points and is fully exempt thru 2026
- Becomes the first player to win the event in debut appearance since Erik van Rooyen (2021)
- Becomes the first PGA TOUR rookie winner since Jake Knapp at the 2024 Mexico Open at Vidanta
- Becomes the first player to win twice in his rookie season since Xander Schauffele (2017)
- Win marks his third top-10 of the season: Won/The American Express, T10/Rocket Mortgage Classic

Additional Notes

- Competing this season on a Major Medical Extension, Vince Whaley (2nd/+47) records his first runner-up finish on TOUR in his third start at this event (MC/2020, T9/2021, T31/2022); previous best finish in 101 starts on TOUR: T5/2022 ISCO Championship
- **Patrick Fishburn** (3rd/+46) records his best result in 17 starts this season in his debut appearance at the Barracuda Championship (previous best: T4 at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Zac Blair)
- Seeking his first win, 54-hole leader and PGA TOUR rookie **Mac Meissner** made four birdies, three bogeys and 10 pars, good for +5 points and solo-fourth finish with 44 total points in his tournament debut

- After entering the week as the highest ranked player in the field at No. 36 in the FedExCup standings, Canada's **Taylor Pendrith** (T5/+43) improves seven spots to No. 29 and records his fifth top-10 finish of the season
- Beginning the final round 10 points off the lead, Patrick Rodgers (T5/+43) collected nine birdies and one bogey en route to a T5 finish in ninth start at the Barracuda Championship (previous best: 2nd/2023); was in search of his first career PGA TOUR title in his 271st start
