#### **Additional Notes**

- The 2023 renovation included every aspect of the golf course, including all new greens, hydronics installed, new bunkers, irrigation and drainage. Bermudagrass was sodded on 118 acres and greens were seeded with bentgrass.
- Area has had a cool, wet spring with more overcast days than full sun days, which slows grass growth.
- This is 4<sup>th</sup> event (2<sup>nd</sup> in a row) on bentgrass greens.
- Fairway landing area widths are 25-30 vards.
