Davis Riley (1st/-10)

- Holds his first 36-hole lead/co-lead on the PGA TOUR; previous best 36-hole position: T3 (2023 Valspar Championship/T19)
- 130 marks his best opening 36-hole score on TOUR (twice; most recent: 131/2024 CJ CUP Byron Nelson, finished T30)
- Seeks second PGA TOUR title in 90th start, first win came at the 2023 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Nick Hardy; paired with Hardy (T60) the first two rounds this week, with Hardy making birdie on final hole to make the cut on the number
- Making third start at the Charles Schwab Challenge (T4/2022, MC/2023)
- In 14 prior starts this season, has made seven cuts (best finish: T14/Texas Children's Houston Open)

Additional Player Notes

- **Hayden Buckley** (T2/-8) seeks to become the sixth player to make the Charles Schwab Challenge their first PGA TOUR victory and first since 2001 (Sergio Garcia)
- PGA TOUR rookie and Plano, Texas native **Pierceson Coody** (T2/-8) records career-low round on TOUR with a 5-under 65; finished sixth in the 2023 Korn Ferry Tour Points List to earn his card for 2024 and has one top-25 this season (T18/ Corales Puntacana Championship)
- **Gary Woodland** (T12/-4) follows a 2-over 72 in the first round with a 64, his best 18-hole score on TOUR since the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open (R1/64, finished T30)
- World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler (T15/-3) follows 72 with a 5-under 65; making fifth start at the Charles Schwab Challenge where he has top-three finishes the last two years (T3/2023, 2nd/2022)
- After missing the cut for this first time in 11 starts at the 2023 Charles Schwab Challenge, 2016 champion Jordan Spieth cards 3-under 67 and sits T25
- Alex Smalley (illness) withdrew before the second round and Grayson Murray (illness) withdrew during the second round

Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5

 The next Signature Event on the schedule is the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday. The cutoff for the Aon Next 10 is through the RBC Canadian Open while the events for the Aon Swing 5 are the Myrtle Beach Classic, Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Canadian Open
