Bud Cauley (1st/-11)

- Second 36-hole lead/co-lead of TOUR career (last: 2017 Valero Texas Open; finished T10)
- Finishes any round inside top five for first time since R1/2020 PGA Championship (T3)
- Best 36-hole score since 2020 American Express (career best: 129/2016 THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- Has played last 29 holes bogey free (last bogey: R1/No. 16)
- Second in field in SG: Putting (5.243)
- Playing on a Major Medical Extension; making second start of season (65th/WM Phoenix Open) after missing the entirety of the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons due to injury

Miscellaneous Notes

- Austin Eckroat (T2/-10) ties second-best 36-hole total of career (best: 131/2024 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- **Garrick Higgo** (T2/-10) played first 33 holes bogey free (first bogey: R2/No. 7); one of five players with one bogey or worse through two rounds
- In 40th career start on TOUR, **Kevin Yu** (T4/-9) starts weekend among the top five for first time (previous best: T7/2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- Making tournament debut, Victor Perez (T4/-9) started 2-over through seven holes; 11-under in next 29 holes
- In seventh start on TOUR and third as a professional, **Nick Dunlap** (T24/-5) made his first TOUR hole-in-one on No. 7 (8-iron, 197 yards), the 15th ace in tournament history (10th at PGA National, third on No. 7)
- Second-round leaders/co-leaders have won one of eight tournaments this season (Jake Knapp/Mexico Open at Vidanta)
- Four second-round leaders/co-leaders went on to win since this event moved to PGA National in 2007 (Most recent: Keith Mitchell/2019)
- Stephan Jaeger (T69/-1) misses the cut, ending his streak of 22 consecutive cuts made in 22 starts, the fourth-longest active streak of consecutive cuts on TOUR Xander Schauffele (39), Viktor Hovland (30), Scottie Scheffler (30), Stephan Jaeger (22)
- Chandler Phillips withdrew during the second round

Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5

• The winner of the Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches will earn a spot in all five remaining Signature Events (if a non-member, must accept membership after the win), while other TOUR members are fighting for spots in the Aon Next 10 and the Aon Swing 5 to earn a place in the field at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard.
