Pre-Tournament Notes – Corales Puntacana Championship

TOUR season notes

- The Corales Puntacana Championship is the first of three events where players can earn points to qualify for the Wells Fargo Championship, the next Signature Event, via the Aon Swing 5. The five players (not exempt via the Aon Next 10 or a higher category) who earn the most FedExCup points in the Corales Puntacana Championship, Zurich Classic of New Orleans and THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson will qualify for the Wells Fargo Championship.

Corales Puntacana Championship notes

- The 2024 Corales Puntacana Championship marks the seventh playing of the PGA TOUR's first and only tournament in the Dominican Republic.
- The winner will receive 300 FedExCup points and a two-year exemption on the PGA TOUR.
- With a winning score of 19-under 269 in 2023, Matt Wallace set the 72-hole score tournament record, earning his first PGA TOUR victory at the 2023 Corales Puntacana Championship.
- Five of the six champions of the Corales Puntacana Championship were in their 30s when they won. Chad Ramey (2022) is the youngest winner at age 29.
- Two players have made the cut in all six editions of the Corales Puntacana Championship: Jonathan Byrd and Brice Garnett. Byrd is making his seventh consecutive start at the event, while Garnett qualified for the RBC Heritage through the Aon Swing 5 by winning the Puerto Rico Open.
- The field includes:
 - Seven of the top 70 in the FedExCup standings, led by No. 49 Mark Hubbard
 - Nine of the top 100 in the Official World Golf Ranking, led by No. 34 Nicolai Højgaard
 - Two past champions (Joel Dahmen/2021, Chad Ramey/2022)
 - 49 PGA TOUR winners combining for 111 wins, led by Billy Horschel (7)
 - Three major champions (Jason Dufner, Francesco Molinari, Jimmy Walker)
 - Two past FedExCup Champions (Bill Haas/2011, Billy Horschel/2014)

Top player notes

- The highest-ranked player in the field at No. 34 in the Official World Golf Ranking, **Nicolai Højgaard** is the only player in the field that competed at last week's Masters Tournament (T16), his best finish in a major. Højgaard has finished runner-up on TOUR twice, recording a solo-second last year at Corales Puntacana Championship and earlier this season at the Farmers Insurance Open.
- At No. 49, **Mark Hubbard** has the highest position in the FedExCup standings of any player in the field. Hubbard has one top-10 in 10 starts this season (T4/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am) and will be making his third consecutive start at the event (MC/2022, T29/2023).
- Seven-time PGA TOUR winner **Billy Horschel** and four-time winner **Daniel Berger** will make their tournament debuts. Berger has won once when making first start at an event (2016 FedEx St. Jude Classic). **Chad Ramey** (2022) was the last player to win in their Corales Puntacana Championship debut.
- Sponsor exemption **Alex Fitzpatrick**, brother of RBC Heritage defending champion Matt Fitzpatrick, will make his tournament debut and fourth start on TOUR (best: T17/2023 Open Championship).
