Kevin Yu (1st/-8)

- Bogey-free 64 on the North Course ties his low first-round score on TOUR (2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship) and is one shy of his career-low of 63 (R4/2024 American Express, R2/2023 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- First career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR
- Missed four months during his rookie season in 2022-23 with a torn meniscus; finished 112th in the FedExCup Fall standings
- Coming off a final-round 63 and T3 finish at The American Express, which tied his career-high finish in 35 starts on TOUR (2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- Third career appearance at the Farmers Insurance Open (MC/2022, T44/2023)

Miscellaneous notes

- Making his first tournament appearance since 2019 and fourth overall, **Patrick Cantlay** (T2/-7) posts 65 on the North Course, his best first-round score at the Farmers Insurance Open; has missed the cut in two of three previous appearances (T51/2018)
- 2023 DP World Tour Rookie of the Year **Ryo Hisatsune** (T2/-7) opens with 65 on the North Course in his eighth career start on TOUR; PGA TOUR rookie earned his card for the 2024 season via the inaugural DP World Tour Top 10, which awarded TOUR cards to the top 10 players on the final 2023 Race to Dubai Points List
- **Hideki Matsuyama** (T4/-6) posts bogey-free 66, including an eagle on the par-5 fifth hole; owns two top-10 finishes in 10 previous tournament appearances (T3/2019, T9/2023)
- In his first tournament appearance since 2018, **Shane Lowry** (T4/-6) makes six birdies in his final eight holes on the North Course and cards 66; missed the cut in his season debut at The American Express
- Making his 22nd career PGA TOUR start and first as a full-time member, **Nicolai Højgaard** (T9/-5) cards 67 to tie the low score on the South Course in round one with Nick Hardy; earned his TOUR card via Special Temporary Membership/non-member FedExCup points and received exemptions into the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational as the highest-ranked player, not otherwise exempt, from the final 2023 Race to Dubai Points List
- After a 2-over front nine on the South Course, defending champion **Max Homa** (T48/-2) closed with four birdies on the back nine to card an opening 70
- Round one score-to-par comparison: North Course (-179), South Course (-3)

The Farmers Insurance Open, the fourth event of the 2024 PGA TOUR Season and third Full-Field Event, marks the third and final opportunity for players to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5. The top five players not otherwise exempt who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express and Farmers Insurance Open will qualify next week's AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.
