Robert MacIntyre (1st/-18)

- Second PGA TOUR title in his 49th career start at 27 years, 11 months, 11 days
- PGA TOUR wins (2): 2024 RBC Canadian Open, 2024 Genesis Scottish Open
- Played the final five holes at The Renaissance Club in 4-under to win
- Third multiple winner on TOUR this season, joining Scottie Scheffler (6) and Rory McIlroy (2); only MacIntyre and Scheffler have won multiple individual stroke-play titles this season
- First-year TOUR member earns 500 points to move from No. 39 to No. 16 in the FedExCup standings
- Projected to move to as high as No. 16 in the Official World Golf Ranking, up from No. 44; previous career high was No. 39 following his win at the 2024 RBC Canadian Open
- Becomes first player to finish runner-up and win the same tournament the next year since Nick Taylor (2023, 2024 WM Phoenix Open)
- Joins Colin Montgomerie (1999) as players from Scotland to win the Genesis Scottish Open in the 42 times it has been played since first being contested on the DP World Tour in 1972
- Third consecutive winner of the Genesis Scottish Open to win by one stroke
- Earned his PGA TOUR card for the 2024 season after finishing No. 7 in the 2023 DP World Tour Top 10

Additional Player Notes

- Adam Scott (2nd/-17) collects his 15th career runner-up finish on TOUR and first since the 2021 Wyndham Championship; after entering the week at No. 71 in the FedExCup, moves to No. 49 with his second top-10 finish of the season (other: T8/WM Phoenix Open)
- 54-hole leader Ludvig Åberg (T4/-14) posts 73 and falls to 1-for-2 when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2023 RSM Classic/Won, 2024 Genesis Scottish Open/T4)
- Defending champion **Rory McIlroy** (T4/-14) records his sixth top-10 finish in 15 starts this season in his bid to successfully defend his first PGA TOUR title at the same venue
- At No. 4, **Collin Morikawa** (T4/-14) owns the highest position in the FedExCup without a win this season after collecting his seventh top-10 finish, including the four in his last six starts
- Aaron Rai (T4/-14) posts bogey-free 63 for his third consecutive top-10 finish on TOUR (T2/Rocket Mortgage Classic, T7/John Deere Classic, T4/Genesis Scottish Open)
- England's **Richard Mansell** (T10/-13) ties the course record at The Renaissance Club with a 61 (Bernd Wiesberger/2019/R2, Cameron Tringale/2022/R1, Byeong Hun An/2023/R1)
- Aaron Rai (T4/-14), Richard Mansell (T10/-13) and Alex Noren (T10/-13) qualify for The Open Championship at Royal Troon as the top three finishers not otherwise exempt
