First-Round Notes - Friday, December 13, 2024

Weather: Partly cloudy. High of 77. Wind ENE 12-17 mph, with gusts to 22 mph.

Format: Three-round 54-hole stroke-play event with 16 teams of two. R1/Scramble, R2/Foursomes, R3/Modified Four-Ball

Scramble: Each player hits a tee shot and then the team selects the ball to be used for the next stroke. From there, both players hit their next shots from that spot. This process continues until the ball is holed.

Jake Knapp/Patty Tavatanakit (1st/-14)

- First-time Grant Thornton Invitational participants post 12 birdies and an eagle on the par-5 17th hole for a 14-under 58
- Open round with nine consecutive birdies to equal the nine-hole scoring record at the event with a front-nine 27
- Represent the only team in the field with both players having won on their respective Tour this season
- Knapp's rookie season highlighted by a win at the 2024 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld
- Tavatanakit, winner of the 2024 Honda LPGA Thailand, is one of six LPGA Tour players in the field with wins this season

Miscellaneous Notes

- 2024 Olympians **Corey Conners/Brooke Henderson** (T2) open with a 13-under 59, including nine birdies and eagles on the par-5 14th and 17th holes; finished runner-up by one stroke to champions Lydia Ko and Jason Day in 2023
- Akshay Bhatia/Jennifer Kupcho (T2) post a 13-under 59; first-time participant Bhatia has two wins on the PGA TOUR (2023
 Barracuda Championship, 2024 Valero Texas Open), while Kupcho owns three LPGA Tour wins (including a major
 championship victory at the 2022 Chevron Championship)
- Defending champions Jason Day/Lydia Ko (T6) card an opening-round 10-under 62
- Daniel Berger and Grant Thornton ambassador Nelly Korda (T8) open with a 9-under 63; World No. 1 Korda has seven victories on the LPGA Tour this season, while Berger entered the field after Tony Finau withdrew with a knee injury
- Rickie Fowler/Lexi Thompson (T8) post an opening-round 9-under 63 on Fowler's 36th birthday
- Grant Thornton ambassadors: Nelly Korda/Daniel Berger (T8/-9), Rickie Fowler/Lexi Thompson (T8/-9), Cameron Champ/Mel Reid (16th/-6)
