Second-Round Notes - Saturday, December 14, 2024

Weather: Scattered showers. High of 79. Wind ENE 13-18 mph, with gusts to 27 mph.

Format: Three-round 54-hole stroke-play event with 16 teams of two. R1/Scramble, R2/Foursomes, R3/Modified Four-Ball

Foursomes: Each team's players alternate hitting shots with the same ball until the ball is holed. One player will tee off on the odd-numbered holes, and the other tees off on the even-numbered holes.

Jake Knapp/Patty Tavatanakit (1st/-20)

- 18-hole leaders record seven birdies and one bogey (No. 4) for a 66 in Foursomes
- Hold the 36-hole lead by two strokes, equaling the largest 36-hole lead at the event (Jason Day and Lydia Ko/2023)
- At 20-under 124, tie the tournament 36-hole scoring record (Day/Ko/2023)
- Represent the only team in the field with both players having won on their respective Tour this season
- Tavantanakit is in her fifth season on the Tour and is one of six LPGA Tour players in the field with wins this season (2024 Honda LPGA Thailand)
- Knapp finished No. 64 in the FedExCup Fall standings after qualifying for the FedExCup Playoffs in his rookie season on TOUR and winning the 2024 Mexico Open at VidantaWorld
- Knapp is one five PGA TOUR and LPGA Tour rookies in the field (others: Nick Dunlap, Max Greyserman, Matthieu Pavon, Gabriela Ruffels)
- First-time Grant Thornton Invitational participants Knapp and Tavatanakit played college golf at UCLA

Miscellaneous Notes

- Tom Kim/Jeeno Thitikul (2nd/-18) set the Grant Thornton Invitational 18-hole Foursomes scoring record with a second round 8-under 64 (previous: 66/Jason Day and Lydia Ko/2023); one of four teams in which both players participated in the women's and men's golf competitions at the 2024 Paris Olympics (Kim/Republic of Korea, Thitikul/Thailand)
- Defending champions **Jason Day/Lydia Ko** (4th/-15) follow an opening round 10-under 62 with a 5-under 67 to sit five shots back entering the final round
- Grant Thornton ambassadors: *Nelly Korda*/Daniel Berger (T10/-11), *Cameron Champ/Mel Reid* (T12/-9), *Rickie Fowler*/Lexi Thompson (T14/-8)
