Cameron Young (1st/-8)

- Hits 12 of 13 fairways and 16 of 18 greens in regulation with 28 putts en route to a bogey-free 64 (-8)
- Eight birdies ties Nick Dunlap for most birdies in Thursday's opening round
- Marks his low 18-hole score in nine rounds at this event; previous: 68 (twice, R3 and R4/2022)
- Makes third appearance at the Hero World Challenge (15th/2023, 3rd/2022)
- Lone player in the field yet to win on the PGA TOUR
- One stroke shy of the best opening round in tournament history (63/Michael Campbell/2005)

Additional Player Notes

- After playing the front nine in even par, Justin Thomas (2nd/-6) adds six birdies on the back nine, including four-consecutive on hole Nos. 14-17; owns top-five finishes in his four most recent appearances at the Hero World Challenge (3rd/2023, 5th/2022, T5/2021, T5/2019)
- Patrick Cantlay (T3/-5) was 6-under on the five par-5 holes, including an eagle at No. 11, best of any player
- Defending champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T3/-5) has never shot an over-par 18-hole score at the Hero World Challenge (13 rounds)
- Three of the eight players making their tournament debuts sit T3 at 5-under (Ludvig Åberg, Akshay Bhatia, Sahith Theegala); others making their tournament debut: Nick Dunlap (T8/-4), Robert MacIntyre (T8/-4), Russell Henley T12/-3), Aaron Rai (16th/-1), Matthieu Pavon (T18/+2)
- Sponsor exemption recipient **Nick Dunlap** (T8/-4), a nominee for the Arnold Palmer Award as PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year, reached 7-under through 15 holes before closing bogey, par, double bogey
