Davis Thompson (Winner/-28)

First PGA TOUR title

- Wins his maiden PGA TOUR victory in his 63rd start at the age of 25 years, 1 month, 2 days
- Earns 500 points to move to No. 22 in the FedExCup standings
- Moves from No. 70 to No. 38 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Becomes the ninth first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Robert MacIntyre (RBC Canadian Open)
- 24th player to make the John Deere Classic his first PGA TOUR victory and first since Dylan Frittelli (2019)
- The victory comes in his second appearance at the John Deere Classic (T31/2023, won/2024)
- Records third consecutive and fourth top-10 of the season (T2/2024 Myrtle Beach Classic, T9/2024 U.S. Open, T2/Rocket Mortgage Classic, won/John Deere Classic)
- Becomes second player to win the week after a runner-up finish on TOUR this season (Xander Schauffele/2024 PGA Championship)

72-hole total: 28-under 256

- Sets lowest 72-hole tournament scoring record by one-stroke (previous: 257/Michael Kim/2018)
- Records lowest score in 72-hole event on the PGA TOUR since Ludvig Åberg at the 2023 RSM Classic
- Career-low 72-hole total (previous: 262/2023 American Express/2nd)

With the 54-hole lead

- Improves to 1-for-2 with 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2nd/2023 American Express, won/2024 John Deere Classic)
- Becomes the 20th player this season to convert 54-hole lead/co-lead to a win
- With a final-round front-nine score of 29, records the lowest front-nine score in the final round by a 54-hole leader since Rory McIlroy at the 2022 RBC Canadian Open (29)

Open Qualifying Series (OQS)

- The two players not otherwise exempt in the top 10 and ties qualified for The 152nd Open Championship at Royal Troon
- Davis Thompson (won) and C.T. Pan (T2) received the exemptions
- Open Championship appearances: Thompson will make debut and Pan will make fourth (MC: 2014, 2019, 2021)
- The John Deere Classic is one of five events in the 2024 PGA TOUR season that is part of the OQS; remaining event: Genesis Scottish Open (3, top 10)

Additional Player Notes

• In his 11th career PGA TOUR start and third as a professional, former Stanford University standout **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T2/-24) earns his career-best finish; became PGA TOUR member after finishing No. 1 in PGA TOUR

University (second player in history to earn membership via this route/Ludvig Åberg)

- Making his third start on TOUR following a T10 at last week's Rocket Mortgage Classic, amateur and sponsor exemption Luke Clanton (T2/-24) becomes the first amateur to finish top 10 in back-to-back starts on TOUR since Billy J. Patton (T8/1957 U.S. Open, T8/1958 Masters); records best finish by an amateur at the John Deere Classic (previous: T15/Patrick Rodgers/2013)
- **C.T. Pan** (T2/-24) earns his third career runner-up and first since 2018 Wyndham Championship; was seeking his second TOUR title in his 193rd start (2019 RBC Heritage)
- After an opening-round 12-under 59 to become the 13th different player (14 times) to shoot a sub-60 round on TOUR, PGA TOUR rookie Hayden Springer (T7/-21) records third top-10 finish in 15 starts (T3/Puerto Rico Open, T10/Rocket Mortgage Classic, T7/John Deere Classic)
