Things to Know

- U.S. Team wins three of four matches with Si Woo Kim and Tom Kim earning the only point for the Internationals
- Due to fog, Round Three was suspended from 7:23 a.m. to 9 a.m., a total suspension of 1 hour and 37 minutes. Two matches teed off prior to suspension and only one hole was completed (Scheffler/Morikawa vs. Scott/Pendrith). Round Three was completed at 2:21 p.m. The first match of Round Four (Homa/Harman vs. Scott/Pendrith) was 2:20 p.m., with adjusted starting times for the final three matches of 2:58 p.m., 3:12 p.m., and 3:26 p.m.

- 21st Four-ball match played by Adam Scott, tied for most in Presidents Cup history (21, Phil Mickelson)
- 12th Four-ball match lost by Adam Scott (most in Presidents Cup history)
- Fourth Four-ball loss in as many career matches by Pendrith who is making his second Presidents Cup start

- First time Tony Finau and Xander Schauffele have been paired together in the Presidents Cup
- Corey Connors and Mackenzie Hughes lose for the first time in second time being paired together (other: Friday Foursomes)

- Second time Si Woo Kim and Tom Kim have been paired together in a Presidents Cup and second win (defeated Patrick Cantlay and Xander Schauffele in Round Four (Four-ball), 1-up, at the 2022 Presidents Cup)
- Si Woo Kim and Tom Kim are the only team to be at least 1-up after each hole for the duration of their match in Round Three

All matches are worth one point, for a total of 30 points. There are no playoffs, with each side receiving a half point if a match is tied after 18 holes. In a change inspired by the events of the 2003 Presidents Cup, if the match is deadlocked at the end of Singles play, the competition will be deemed a tie and the teams will share the Presidents Cup.
