



2024 Presidents Cup: Round Four Results and Notes

Things to Know

- For the second straight year, the United States Team leads the International Team, 11-7, heading into Round Five Singles
- Following a delay in Round Three due to fog, the first match of Round Four (Match 16: Homa/Harman vs. Scott/Pendrith) began at 2:20 p.m., with adjusted starting times for the final three matches of 2:58 p.m., 3:12 p.m., and 3:26 p.m. With three of the four matches going to 18 holes, Round Four was completed at 7 p.m.
- Adam Scott (with partner Taylor Pendrith) records 20th career match victory as the only International win in Round Four
- Sam Burns is the only player undefeated on the week (3-0-0)
- Second time in Presidents Cup history a tie has not been recorded in either team format (other: 2000)
- Five players did not play Round Three (Four-ball) or Round Four (Foursomes) on Saturday:
 - International (4): Byeong Hun An, Christiaan Bezuidenhout, Jason Day, Min Woo Lee
 - U.S. (1): Sahith Theegala
- Nine players have played all four rounds:
 - International (5): Corey Connors, Sungjae Im, Hideki Matsuyama, Taylor Pendrith, Adam Scott
 - U.S. (4): Patrick Cantlay, Collin Morikawa, Xander Schauffele, Scottie Scheffler
- Patrick Cantlay and Xander Schauffele played their ninth career Presidents Cup match together, the most in event history

Match 16: Adam Scott/Taylor Pendrith (INT) def. Brian Harman/Max Homa (U.S.), 2-up

- Third straight session Adam Scott and Taylor Pendrith have been paired together (2-1-0); both victories came in Foursomes
- 53rd match played by Adam Scott (second-most in Presidents Cup history; most: 55, Phil Mickelson)
- 20th match won by Adam Scott (tied for most by an International player; other: Ernie Els)
- 22nd Foursomes match played by Adam Scott (tied for most in Presidents Cup history; other: Phil Mickelson)
- 10th Foursomes match won by Adam Scott (most by an International player and third-most by any player; most: 12, Tiger Woods, U.S., Phil Mickelson, U.S.)
- 23 career points by Adam Scott (most by an International player; next: 21, Ernie Els)
- Max Homa and rookie Brian Harman have been paired together twice and lost on both occasions

Match 17: Collin Morikawa/Sam Burns (U.S.) def. Corey Connors/Mackenzie Hughes (INT), 1-up

- Sam Burns wins first career Foursomes match in first match paired with Collin Morikawa
- Burns is the only player undefeated this week (3-0-0)
- Canadians Connors and Hughes are 1-2-0 for the week when paired together

Match 18: Patrick Cantlay/Xander Schauffele (U.S.) def. Si Woo Kim/Tom Kim (INT), 1-up

- Ninth time Cantlay and Schauffele have played together in a Presidents Cup match (most in history; next: 8, Fred Couples/Davis Love III, U.S.)
- Third time Si Woo Kim and Tom Kim have been paired together in a Presidents Cup and first loss
 - 2022: defeated Patrick Cantlay and Xander Schauffele in Round Four (Four-ball), 1-up
 - 2024: defeated Keegan Bradley and Wyndham Clark in Round Three (Four-Ball), 4 and 3

Miscellaneous notes

All matches are worth one point, for a total of 30 points. There are no playoffs, with each side receiving a half point if a match is tied after 18 holes. In a change inspired by the events of the 2003 Presidents Cup, if the match is deadlocked at the end of Singles play, the competition will be deemed a tie and the teams will share the Presidents Cup.
