David Lipsky (1st/-7)

- Opens with a 65, one stroke shy of his career-low score on TOUR (64, four times; most recent: 2023 3M Open/R2)
- Seeking first win in 105th PGA TOUR start; has career-best T4 finishes at the 2022 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with partner Aaron Rai) and 2023 Sony Open in Hawaii
- Holds second 18-hole lead/co-lead in an individual stroke-play event on TOUR (2022 Valspar Championship/finished T68): also shared the first-round lead at the 2024 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with partner Aaron Rai (finished T23)
- Enters the week at No. 163 in the FedExCup standings and is currently projected No. 73
- Making fourth start at the Procore Championship (T22/2021, MC/2022, T30/2023)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (3.691)
- Lone top-10 finish in 22 starts this season (T9/Charles Schwab Challenge)
- Has two DP World Tour victories (2018 Alfred Dunhill Championship, 2014 Omega European Masters), one Korn Ferry Tour win (2020 TPC San Antonio Challenge at the Canyons), and one Asian Tour win (2012 Handa Faldo Cambodian Classic)

Miscellaneous Notes

- Making his 399th start, four-time PGA TOUR winner **Martin Laird** (T2) cards a 6-under 66, his best round on TOUR since opening the 2024 Charles Schwab Challenge with a 66 (finished T37); has two top-10s in 19 starts on TOUR this season (T9/Cognizant Classic, T10/Puerto Rico Open)
- Patton Kizzire (T2/-6) posts 66 to sit T2, his highest position after round one since the 2021 Valspar Championship (finished T60)
- Defending champion Sahith Theegala (T22) opens with a 3-under 69; seeks to become the second player to defend a title
 on TOUR this season (Scottie Scheffler/THE PLAYERS Championship)

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The 2024 Procore Championship marks the first year with Procore as title sponsor and is the first of the FedExCup Fall, a group of eight tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2025 PGA TOUR Season
- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Currently no players are projected to move into or fall out of Nos. 51-60

- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
- Currently projected to move into the Top 125: **David Lipsky** (1st; from No. 163 to No. 73), **Patton Kizzire** (T2; from No. 132 to No. 89), **Martin Laird** (T2; from No. 145 to No. 98)
- Currently projected to fall out of the Top 125: Vince Whaley (T100; from No. 121 to No. 127), Hayden Springer (T100; from No. 124 to No. 128), Sam Ryder (T136; from No. 125 to No. 129)
