Patton Kizzire (1st/-13)

- Second 36-hole lead/co-lead in 242 PGA TOUR starts (2017 World Wide Technology Championship/won)
- Making his 176th start since winning the most recent of his two PGA TOUR victories (2018 Sony Open in Hawaii)
- Enters the week No. 132 in the FedExCup standings and is currently projected No. 70
- Two top-10 finishes in 18 starts this season: Barracuda Championship (T8), Myrtle Beach Classic (T10)
- Making eighth start at the Procore Championship, with a runner-up finish in his first start in 2016 his lone top-10 finish

Miscellaneous Notes

- First-round leader David Lipsky (2nd/-12) cards a second-round 5-under 67 to fall one behind Kizzire
- Patrick Fishburn (3rd/-11) has three top-15 finishes in his last four starts on TOUR (ISCO Championship/15th, Barracuda Championship/3rd, 3M Open/T6, Wyndham Championship/MC)
- A victory Sunday for **Matt Kuchar** (T4/-10) would come at the age of 46 years, 2 months, 25 days, which would make him the TOUR's oldest winner since Phil Mickelson won the 2021 PGA Championship (50 years, 11 months, 7 days); now has four rounds of 64 or better in his last eight rounds on TOUR (63/3M Open/R3, 64/Wyndham Championship/R1/R2, 64/Procore Championship/R2); this week marks his 399th made cut in 557 PGA TOUR starts
- Sahith Theegala (6th/-9) trails by four in bid to become the third player to win the Procore Championship in back-to-back seasons since the event moved to Silverado Resort in 2014 (Brendan Steele/2016-17, Max Homa/2021-22)
- Grouped together during the first two rounds, the three International Presidents Cup team members in the field all sit T10 at 7-under: Corey Conners (73-64), Mackenzie Hughes (70-67), Min Woo Lee (68-69)
- Of the three U.S. Presidents Cup team members in the field, Theegala is the only one who made the cut (Max Homa/-1, Wyndham Clark/+2)
- C.T. Pan withdrew prior to the second round with a neck injury

FedExCup Fall Notes

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)
 - Currently no players are projected to move into Nos. 51-60
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR
 - Currently projected to move into the Top 125: Patton Kizzire (1st; from No. 132 to No. 70), David Lipsky (2nd; from No. 163 to No. 102), Greyson Sigg (T10; from No. 130 to No. 123)
 - Currently projected to fall out of the Top 125: Vince Whaley (MC; from No. 121 to No. 127), Hayden Springer (MC; from No. 124 to No. 128), Sam Ryder (MC; from No. 125 to No. 129)
