Today –Light showers have developed ahead of a weak disturbance early this morning. These showers have been weakening as they approach the coast. A passing sprinkle or very light shower will be possible through mid-morning before moving to the east. Otherwise, partly to mostly cloudy skies can be expected with highs in the low 80s. An isolated shower or thunderstorm may develop along the sea breeze during the late afternoon or early evening hours.

Extended forecast – Another warm and humid day can be expected Saturday with highs in the low 80s. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will be possible during the afternoon as the sea breeze moves inland. Storms could be strong with gusty winds and heavy rainfall. Another cold front will move across the state Sunday bringing a good chance for showers and a few thunderstorms during the afternoon and continuing into the Sunday night. Showers will likely taper-off by Monday morning with cooler temperatures in the 60s.
