Today –Mostly sunny skies can be expected this morning before skies become partly cloudy during the afternoon. It will be another warm day with highs warming into the low 80s before sea breeze slowly moves inland. Cannot rule out an isolated shower or thunderstorm developing along the sea breeze this afternoon, but most locations will remain dry. Showers and thunderstorms will be likely later this evening into the overnight as the cold front moves across the area.

Extended forecast – Sunday will likely start the day dry with mostly cloudy skies before an area of showers and a few thunderstorms moves across the southeast during the afternoon into the early evening hours. Rainfall could be heavy at times, especially with thunderstorms. Temperatures will be much cooler with temperatures remaining steady in the low 70s before cooling into the 60s late in the day. Total Rainfall: 0.40”-0.60”.
