**Today** –High clouds streaming over the area will make for mostly cloudy skies this morning before shifting to the south. Skies will become mostly sunny for the afternoon with highs warming into the low 80s before the sea breeze moves on-shore cooling it back into the 70s. Light wind this morning will increase to 10-15 mph by early afternoon as the sea breeze moves inland.

**Extended forecast** — Warm temperatures can be expected Friday with highs in the low to mid 80s. There is a slight chance for a t-storm to develop along the sea breeze during the afternoon, but most locations will remain rain free. A better chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms will be Saturday afternoon as the sea breeze moves inland. Storms could be strong with gusty winds and heavy rainfall. Another cold front will move across the state Sunday into Monday with showers and thunderstorms becoming likely by late in the day and continuing into Monday morning.
