Playoff at 2024 Sanderson Farms Championship

- Eighth playoff this season (first since Harry Hall def. Pierceson Coody and Matt NeSmith at ISCO Championship)
- Marks ninth playoff at the Sanderson Farms Championship (since 1994) and the fourth at the Country Club of Jackson (2019, 2022, 2023, 2024)
- Playoff records:

Beau Hossler: 0-2Kevin Yu: 0-1

Kevin Yu (Winner/-23)

- First career PGA TOUR win in his 56th start at the age of 26 years, 1 month, 25 days
- Becomes 12th first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Aaron Rai (Wyndham Championship)
- 14th player to earn his first TOUR title at the Sanderson Farms Championship (most recent: Sebastian Munoz/2019)
- Becomes first Chinese Taipei winner on TOUR since C.T. Pan (2019 RBC Heritage)
- At 23-under 265, sets the Sanderson Farms Championship scoring record since the event moved to the Country Club of Jackson (previous: 266/Scott Stallings/2012)
- Collects 500 points and moves to No. 60 in the FedExCup Standings after entering the week No. 96
- Moves to No. 71 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Records fifth top-10 finishes in 23 starts this season
- Win comes in third start at the event (T19/2022, MC/2023, won/2024)
- Finished No. 4 in the inaugural 2020-21 PGA TOUR University class to earn Korn Ferry Tour status for the 2022 season
- In his second season on the PGA TOUR after finishing No. 20 in the Korn Ferry Tour Points List in 2022; joined the PGA TOUR as a rookie at the start of the 2022-23 season

Beau Hossler (P2/-23)

- Fourth runner-up finish on TOUR (2024/Sanderson Farms Championship, 2023/ ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, 2018/Travelers Championship, 2018/Texas Children's Houston Open)
- 23-under 265 marks career-best 72-hole score on TOUR (previous: 266)
- Moves to No. 68 in the FedExCup standings after entering the week No. 87

Additional Player Note

• After making his first Sanderson Farms Championship cut in his fifth start at the event, **Keith Mitchell** (T3/-22) falls to 0-for-3 with the 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2021 Wells Fargo Championship/T3, 2024 Valspar Championship/T17); was seeking his second career victory in his 185th start (2019 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches)

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The 2024 Sanderson Farms Championship is the second event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of eight tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2025 PGA TOUR Season.
- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)
 - o Players to move into Nos. 51-60: **Kevin Yu** (P1; from No. 96 to No. 60)
 - o Players to fall out of Nos. 51-60: Min Woo Lee (not in field; from No. 60 to No. 61)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR
 - o Players to move into the Top 125: **Hayden Springer** (T8; from No. 127 to No. 115), **Alex Smalley** (T5; from No. 132 to No. 116), **Vince Whaley** (T16; from No. 126 to No. 121)
 - Players to fall out of the Top 125: Pierceson Coody (MC; from No. 121 to No. 127), Dylan Wu (MC; from No. 122 to No. 128), Matt NeSmith (T48; from No. 124 to No. 130)
