**Today** – Wind Advisory through 11PM Friday! Mostly sunny skies can be expected again today but will be a little cooler with highs in the low to mid 80s. The wind will be increasing this afternoon out of the S-SW 15-20 gusting to 30 mph by late in the day as a deep trough of low-pressure begins to move towards the region. The wind will increase further after midnight out of the N-NW 25-35 gusting 40-50 mph with temperatures dropping into the upper 50s.

**Extended forecast** – An upper-level low-pressure will move across the region Friday producing windy and much cooler temperatures with highs in the 60s. The wind will be strong out of the NNW 25-30 gusting to 45 mph at times. The wind speeds will gradually decrease through the day Friday with the wind advisory expiring at 11pm. Showers will be possible early Friday morning, but the bulk of the precipitation is expected to stay to our north and east as it passes. Breezy conditions Saturday morning will decrease and become light for the afternoon. Otherwise, temperatures will warm into the low 70s.
