**Today** – A cold front will move across the Oahu this afternoon. A low (20-25%) threat for a shower will exist ahead of the front, otherwise the highest shower threat is expected between 2-6pm as the cold front passes through Waialae. Strong westerly winds will quickly develop ahead of the front, veering towards the northwest behind the front. Gusts over 30 mph could occur this afternoon, especially with the frontal passage. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 7:10am / Sunset: 6:06pm**

**Extended forecast** – Northerly flow will usher in a relatively dry airmass for Hawaii on Friday. Showers will generally focus along the north shore of Oahu Thursday night into Friday, however some light activity could make it into Honolulu. By this weekend, the threat for precipitation will drop closer to 0%. Breezy north winds will be possible on Friday with gusts of 20-25 mph, mainly during the afternoon. Winds will diminish Saturday and more so into Sunday.
