Additional Notes

- Green contours were restored on No. 10 and 15 in the summer to restore pin locations. The square footage remained the same as the grass was lifted and greens cavities re-floated, and the grass was then put back exactly as it had been removed.
- The average green size of 7,500 sq. ft. ties for 4th largest on tour.
- Average fairway width is 27 yards.
- Wildlife on the course include coyote, raccoons, hawks and parrots.
- Riviera will host the 2026 U.S. Women's Open and the 2028 Summer Olympics.
