**Patrick Cantlay (1<sup>st</sup>/-14)**

- Fifth career 54-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR (not including FedExCup Starting Strokes) and first since 2022 Shriners Children’s Open where he finished T2; 2-for-4 to date (2021 and 2022 BMW Championship)
- Held a two-stroke lead after the third round of the 2021 TOUR Championship and went on to win by one stroke (entered the tournament with a two-stroke lead at 10-under due to FedExCup Starting Strokes)
- Held a five-stroke lead through 54 holes with partner Xander Schauffele at the 2022 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (went on to win by two strokes)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (7.387)
- A win this week would be his ninth on the PGA TOUR (most recent: 2022 BMW Championship)
- Two top-five finishes in eight previous starts at The Genesis Invitational: T4/2018, 3<sup>rd</sup>/2023
- Cantlay and Schauffele play in the final group in the final round together for the third time in an individual stroke-play event on TOUR (2022 Travelers Championship/Schauffele won; 2022 BMW Championship/Cantlay won)

**Will Zalatoris (T2/-12)**

- In fourth start on TOUR this season, looks for second career TOUR title and first since the 2022 FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Would be second player to win this season competing on a sponsor exemption, joining Nick Dunlap at The American Express
- Made first career TOUR start (amateur) at the 2015 Genesis Invitational (MC) after winning inaugural Genesis Invitational Collegiate Showcase as an 18-year-old freshman at Wake Forest
- Holds one top-10 finish (4<sup>th</sup>/2023) in four starts at The Genesis Invitational

**Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Xander Schauffele** (T2/-12) signs for a 6-under 65, his career-low score in 27 career rounds at The Riviera Country Club; a win this week would be his eighth on the PGA TOUR and first since the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open
- **Luke List** (4<sup>th</sup>/-11) seeks his third TOUR victory in as many seasons (2022 Farmers Insurance Open, 2023 Sanderson Farms Championship); best result in eight prior starts at The Genesis Invitational: T15/2019; ranks No. 1 in Scrambling (15 of 17)
- In his ninth Genesis Invitational start, **Harris English** (T5/-10) posts a bogey-free 6-under 65, which ties his career-low score at The Riviera Country Club (65/R4/2023); lone top-10 finish in the event, T10, came in 2014; seeks his fifth career PGA TOUR title and first since the 2021 Travelers Championship
- In seven appearances at The Genesis Invitational, **Jason Day** (T5/-10) posts three consecutive rounds in the 60s to open the event for the first time; a win this week would be his 14<sup>th</sup> on the PGA TOUR (most recent: 2023 CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- **Corey Connors** (T7/-8) is one of four Canadian players in the top 10 through 54 holes: Adam Svensson (T10/-7), Adam Hadwin (T10/-7) and Mackenzie Hughes (T10/-7)
