Outlook for Monday

- **Rest of Monday 22nd July** – Persistent, possibly very heavy rain at first is expected to largely ease early Monday morning, but with a continued risk of further, lighter rain until late morning or early afternoon. Some bright or sunny spells developing into the afternoon but a chance for the odd afternoon shower. Becoming rather breezy. Fine, dry through the evening with winds easing. Rainfall: Most likely 2-5mm, 20% chance up to 10mm, mostly falling in the morning. Winds: E to NE 5-8mph gusting 8-12mph, turning W to NW 5-10mph, gusts 10-15mph by mid-evening.
