Xander Schauffele (1st/-17)

- Third-round 65 marks his second career score of 65 or lower and second career bogey-free round at THE PLAYERS
- Third player in tournament history with a 54-hole score of 199 or better:
 - 197 (19-under), Webb Simpson, 2018 (66-63-68)
 - 197 (19-under), Greg Norman, 1994 (63-67-67)
 - 199 (17-under), Xander Schauffele, 2024 (65-69-65)
- Seventh career 54-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR; 2-for-6 in converting to victory, including his two most recent titles (2022 Genesis Scottish Open, 2022 Travelers Championship)
- 16th time in last group of the final round on TOUR since the start of the 2018 season, tied with Jon Rahm for the second-most of any player behind Rory McIlroy (20)
- World No. 6 seeks to become the fifth consecutive PLAYERS Champion to win after entering the week inside the top 10 of the Official World Golf Ranking:

• Began the third round four strokes behind Wyndham Clark; has won four of his six individual stroke-play titles after trailing by four strokes or more through 36 holes:

- Most recent of seven PGA TOUR titles came at the 2022 Genesis Scottish Open; has 15 top-10s since the start of the 2022-23 season, the second-most of any player in that span (22, Scottie Scheffler)
- Four top-10s on TOUR this season (T10/The Sentry, T3/The American Express, T9/Farmers Insurance Open, T4/The Genesis Invitational), tied with Sam Burns for the second-most on TOUR this season (5, Scottie Scheffler)
- Finished T2 at the 2018 PLAYERS Championship in his tournament debut and finished T19 in 2023 (MC in 2019, 2021, 2022)

Wyndham Clark (2nd/-16)

- 36-hole leader posts 70 in search of his fourth win on TOUR in his last 17 starts
- Finished solo-second at last week's Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard; only player with a win and a runner-up this season

- Earned his third career PGA TOUR title at the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am; all three wins have come in the last two seasons (2023 Wells Fargo Championship, 2023 U.S. Open, 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am)
- Making fifth start at THE PLAYERS Championship; made the cut for the first time in 2023 and finished T27 (DQ/2019, MC/2021, MC/2022)
- PLAYERS Championship winners who also won the U.S. Open: Lee Trevino, Jerry Pate, Jack Nicklaus, Raymond Floyd, Tom Kite, Lee Janzen, Tiger Woods, Martin Kaymer, Webb Simpson, Rory McIlroy

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Brian Harman** (3rd/-15) sets the lowest middle 36-hole total of 129 (65-64) at THE PLAYERS; had yet to post a score of 65 or better in his first 39 rounds at TPC Sawgrass; owns three top-10s in 11 previous tournament appearances, including a T3 in 2021, and would become the second left-hander to win THE PLAYERS (Phil Mickelson/2007)
- The only player inside the top six on the leaderboard without a victory on TOUR, **Maverick McNealy** (T4/-13) seeks to join Tim Clark (2010) and Craig Perks (2002) as players to make THE PLAYERS Championship their first victory on TOUR; owns one top-10 in seven starts this season (T6/WM Phoenix Open)
- Matt Fitzpatrick (T4/-13) closes with a career-best 31 on the back nine at TPC Sawgrass (previous: 33/R2/2021) to post three consecutive rounds in the 60s (66-69-68); owns one top-10 in seven previous tournament appearances (T9/2021)
- Sahith Theegala (T6/-12) plays his last four holes in 4-under (birdie-eagle-birdie-par) to post consecutive 67s; making his third appearance at THE PLAYERS (MC/2022, 74th/2023)
- Defending champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T6/-12) birdies the final three holes to post his seventh consecutive round of 69 or better at THE PLAYERS following a third-round 68; no player has successfully defended a title at THE PLAYERS (best finish by a defending champion is T5 by three players: Hal Sutton/2001, Tom Kite/1990, Jack Nicklaus/1977)
