Scottie Scheffler (Winner/-20)

Eighth career PGA TOUR title

- Earns his eighth career PGA TOUR title in his 118th start at the age of 27 years, 8 months, 25 days
- PGA TOUR wins (8):** 2022 WM Phoenix Open, 2022 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, 2022 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, 2022 Masters Tournament, 2023 WM Phoenix Open, 2023 PLAYERS Championship, 2024 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, 2024 PLAYERS Championship
- All eighth wins have come since the start of the 2021-22 season, the most of any player in that span (second: 5, Rory McIlroy and Jon Rahm)
- Ties Jon Rahm for most wins since joining the PGA TOUR at the start of the 2019-20 season
- First player with multiple wins in three consecutive PGA TOUR seasons since Dustin Johnson (2015-16 through 2017-18)

Successfully defends his title at THE PLAYERS Championship

- First player to successfully defend a title at THE PLAYERS Championship
- Becomes the eighth multiple winner of THE PLAYERS Championship and first since Tiger Woods won his second title in 2013

- Successfully defends a title for the second time on the PGA TOUR (first: 2023 WM Phoenix Open)

Wins on TOUR in back-to-back weeks

- Wins the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard and THE PLAYERS Championship in back-to-back weeks
- First player to win back-to-back tournaments on the PGA TOUR schedule since Viktor Hovland during the 2023 FedExCup Playoffs (BMW Championship, TOUR Championship)

- First player to win on TOUR and successfully defend a title the following week since Tiger Woods in 2007 (won the 2007 PGA Championship and successfully defended his title at the WGC-Bridgestone Invitational the following week)
- Fourth player to win the week before THE PLAYERS Championship and go on to win (first since Tiger Woods in 2001)

Wins by one stroke at 20-under 268

- 72-hole total of 20-under 268 is the second-lowest winning score in tournament history and lowest since Greg Norman in 1994 (24-under 264)
- Final-round 64 ties the lowest final-round score by a winner in tournament history (Fred Couples/1996, Davis Love III/2003)
- Final-round 64 is the second-lowest final-round score of his TOUR career and lowest since the 2022 World Wide Technology Championship (62)
- Second consecutive year with four scores in the 60s (68-69-65-69 in 2023, 67-69-68-64 in 2024); only player in tournament history to do so in two different years
- All three runners-up missed birdie putts at the 72nd hole to force a playoff

- Second player in the FedExCup era (est. 2007) to enter THE PLAYERS at No. 1 in the FedExCup standings and win

High finishes

- 25th top-three finish since joining the PGA TOUR at the start of the 2019-20 season, five more than any other player in that span (second: 19, Jon Rahm)
- 36th top-five since joining the PGA TOUR at the start of the 2019-20 season, nine more than any other player in that span (second: 27, Xander Schauffele)
- 49th top-10 since joining the PGA TOUR at the start of the 2019-20 season, seven more than any other player in that span (second: 41, Jon Rahm)

Miscellaneous Notes

- **Xander Schauffele** (T2/-19), who also finished T2 in 2018, is one of 10 players in tournament history with multiple runner-up finishes (no one has more than two)
- **Wyndham Clark** (T2/-19) has finished runner-up in each of the last two TOUR events (2nd/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, T2/THE PLAYERS Championship), becoming the first player to finish runner-up in consecutive weeks since Lee Westwood at the same two tournaments in 2021
- **Brian Harman** (T2/-19) records his fourth runner-up finish since the start of the 2022-23 season, the most of any player in that span (2nd/2022 World Wide Technology Championship, T2/2022 RSM Classic, T2/2023 Travelers Championship, T2/2024 PLAYERS Championship)
- **Sam Ryder** (T16/-10) records 27 birdies for the week, breaking the tournament record for most birdies or better in a single year; the record was previously held by Fuzzy Zoeller, who made 26 in 1994
