## Maverick McNealy (T1/-8) - SS

- Beginning his round on No. 10 of the Seaside Course, played Nos. 12-16 in 5-under en route to a career-low 8-under 62
- First career 18-hole lead; best previous 18-hole position T2; 2022 Shriners Children's Open, 2024 WM Phoenix Open
- RSM Classic history: T58/2023, MC/2020, T53/2019
- Most recent of five top-10 finishes in 27 starts this season was T6/World Wide Technology Championship; comes off a T17 at last week's Butterfield Bermuda Championship
- Has two career runner-ups in 141 TOUR starts: 2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2021 Procore Championship
- Qualified for the FedEx St. Jude Championship (T12) and finished No. 53 through the FedExCup Playoffs; is currently No. 52 in the FedExCup Fall as he seeks to finish inside the Aon Next 10 (Nos. 51-60) to qualify for two Signature Events in 2025 (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)

# Michael Thorbjornsen (T1/-8) – PL

- In his 19<sup>th</sup> career PGA TOUR start and 11<sup>th</sup> as a professional, former Stanford University standout opened with a bogey-free, career-low 8-under 62 (previously: 63, three times) on the Plantation Course
- First career 18-hole lead; best 18-hole position prior to this week was 2<sup>nd</sup>/2024 Sanderson Farms Championship (T8)
- 23-year-old Cleveland, Ohio native became a PGA TOUR rookie in 2024 after finishing No. 1 in PGA TOUR University (second player in history to earn membership via this route, joining Ludvig Åberg); is exempt through 2025
- Has three career top-10 finishes: 2024 John Deere Classic (T2), 2024 Sanderson Farms Championship (T8), 2022 Travelers Championship (4<sup>th</sup>, as amateur)

# **Additional Player Notes**

- Three players who finished in the top 10 at last week's Butterfield Bermuda Championship are currently inside the top 10 of the leaderboard: 3<sup>rd</sup>, Andrew Novak (2<sup>nd</sup>/Butterfield Bermuda Championship), T3, Adrien Dumont de Chassart (T3/Butterfield Bermuda Championship), T6, Patrick Rodgers (T9/Butterfield Bermuda Championship)
- In his first start since knee surgery (left), defending champion Ludvig Aberg (T135) opened with a 3-over 73 (SS)

#### FedExCup Fall Notes

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Currently projected to move into Nos. 51-60: Kevin Yu (T6; from No. 61 to 57), Andrew Novak (3<sup>rd</sup>; from No. 70 to 58)
- Currently projected to fall out of Nos. 51-60: Nick Taylor (DNP; from No. 58 to 61), Justin Rose (DNP; from No. 60 to 62)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
- Currently projected to move into the Top 125: Michael Thorbjornsen (T1; from No. 138 to 77), Dylan Wu (T13; from No. 131 to 121), Adrien Dumont de Chassart (T4; from No. 142 to 124)
- Currently projected to fall out of the Top 125: Wesley Bryan (T34; from No. 125 to 126), Zac Blair (T80; from No. 123 to 127), Joel Dahmen (T101; from No. 124 to 128)
