Patrick Fishburn (1st/-11) - SS-PL

- PGA TOUR rookie enters the final event of the FedExCup Fall at No. 87 in the FedExCup Fall standings
- First career lead after any round on TOUR
- 131 marks career-low 36-hole score (previously: 133, twice, 2024 Shriners Children's Open, 2024 Procore Championship)
- Utah native missed the cut in seven of first eight starts in 2024; has four top-10s in 25 starts this season: T4/Zurich Classic of New Orleans, 3rd/Barracuda Championship, T6/3M Open, 3rd/Procore Championship
- Nine players have made The RSM Classic their maiden PGA TOUR title (most recent: Ludvig Åberg/2023)

Additional Player Notes

- First-round co-leader **Maverick McNealy** (T2) followed a career-low 62 in round one with a 2-under 70 on the Plantation Course; qualified for the FedEx St. Jude Championship (T12) and finished No. 53 through the FedExCup Playoffs
- Lee Hodges (T2), who is on a tournament winner's exemption through 2025, is currently No. 81 in the FedExCup Fall
- First-round co-leader **Michael Thorbjornsen** is two back after a second-round 69 on the Seaside Course; the 23-year-old Cleveland, Ohio native became a PGA TOUR rookie in 2024 after finishing No. 1 in PGA TOUR University (second player in history to earn membership via this route, joining Ludvig Åberg); is exempt through 2025
- Amateur Luke Clanton (T4), who has two top-fives on TOUR in 2024 (T2/John Deere Classic, 5th/Wyndham Championship) is competing on his seventh and final sponsor exemption of the 2024 season; the Florida State junior received 1 point in PGA TOUR University Accelerated for making the cut, bringing his total to 16 points; if he reaches 20 points by the end of the 2024-25 collegiate season, he will become the second player to earn PGA TOUR membership through PGA TOUR University Accelerated (first: Gordon Sargent); he can get an additional point this week with a top-10 finish
- A day after he opened with a 3-over 73 on the Seaside Course, defending champion **Ludvig Åberg** (T17) moved 118 spots up the leaderboard with a 8-under 64 on the Plantation Course; is making his first start since left knee surgery in September

FedExCup Fall Notes

- Nos. 1-50 in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions, while Nos. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points into the Fall; Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2024 via the Aon Next 10: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Currently projected to move into Nos. 51-60: Patrick Fishburn (1st; No. 87 to 56), Kevin Yu (T9; from No. 61 to 59)
- Currently projected to fall out of Nos. 51-60: Nick Taylor (DNP; from No. 58 to 61), Justin Rose (DNP; from No. 60 to 62)
- The Top 125 will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season and Nos. 126-150 will earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR next season
- Currently projected to move into the Top 125: **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T4; from No. 138 to 119), **Daniel Berger** (T17; from No. 127 to 120)
