Maverick McNealy (Won/-16)

- Wins first career PGA TOUR victory in 142nd career start at the age of 29 years, 17 days
- 15th first-time winner of the season and fourth in FedExCup Fall: Kevin Yu (Sanderson Farms Championship), Matt McCarty (Black Desert Championship), Rafael Campos (Butterfield Bermuda Championship), Maverick McNealy (The RSM Classic)
- 10th player to win first career TOUR title at The RSM Classic and fourth consecutive: Talor Gooch (2021), Adam Svensson (2022), Ludvig Åberg (2023), Maverick McNealy (2024)
- 1-for-2 in converting 54-hole lead/co-leads on TOUR (2021 Procore Championship/finished 2nd, 2024 RSM Classic/Won)
- 1-for-1 in converting 18-hole lead/co-leads on TOUR (2024 RSM Classic/Won)
- Recorded a career-low 62 in round one
- Career-best sixth top-10 of the season
- With the victory, earns a two-year PGA TOUR exemption, 500 FedExCup points, and invitations to The Sentry, Masters Tournament and PGA Championship in 2025; maintains position inside the Aon Next 10 (moves to No. 51, entered the week No. 52) to qualify for two Signature Events in 2025: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
- Qualified for the FedEx St. Jude Championship (T12) and finished No. 53 through the FedExCup Playoffs

Additional Player Notes

- Amateur Luke Clanton (T2) records his third top-five of the 2024 PGA TOUR Season (T2/John Deere Classic, 5th/Wyndham Championship, 2nd/The RSM Classic) and fourth top-10 (T10/Rocket Mortgage Classic); the Florida State junior entered the week with 15 points in PGA TOUR University Accelerated, and moved to 17 points with 1 point for making the cut and 1 point for finishing in the top 10; if he reaches 20 points by the end of the 2024-25 collegiate season, he will become the second player to earn PGA TOUR membership through PGA TOUR University Accelerated (first: Gordon Sargent); records best finish by an amateur at The RSM Classic (previously: T23/Davis Thompson/2019)
- 2024 ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP winner **Nico Echavarria** (T2) records his fourth top-10 of the season, with three coming in his last four starts: (Win/ZOZO CHAMPIONSHIP, T6/World Wide Technology Championship, T2/The RSM Classic)
- In last start of a tournament winner's exemption, **Daniel Berger** (T2) moved from No. 127 to No. 100 to secure TOUR membership for 2025; marks best finish since most recent of four TOUR wins at the 2021 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- In first title defense, 2023 RSM Classic champion Ludvig Åberg finishes T17 in first start since left knee surgery in September

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The RSM Classic was the final event of the FedExCup Fall to determine the Top 125, players who will be exempt into all Full-Field events and THE PLAYERS next season; Nos. 126-150 earn full Korn Ferry Tour status and conditional status on TOUR
- Two players moved into the Top 125: Daniel Berger (T2; from No. 127 to 100), Henrik Norlander (T17; from No. 126 to 120)
- Two players moved out of the Top 125: Zac Blair (MC; from No. 123 to 126), Wesley Bryan (MC; from No. 125 to 128)
- Nos. 51-60 through the FedExCup Fall qualify for two Signature Events in 2025 via the Aon Next 10: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational; One player moved into the Aon Next 10: Kevin Yu (T11, from No. 61 to 58); One player fell out of the Aon Next 10: Justin Rose (DNP, From No. 60 to 62)
