Chris Kirk (1st/-21)

- Making his first start at The Sentry since 2016, holds the 54-hole lead/co-lead for the seventh time on TOUR (3-for-6 to date; 2011 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2013 RSM Classic, 2023 Honda Classic)
- Seeks sixth career PGA TOUR win in 331st start (2011 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2013 RSM Classic, 2014 Deutsche Bank Championship, 2015 Charles Schwab Challenge, 2023 Honda Classic)
- Making his fifth start at The Sentry (T7/2012, T16/2014, T14/2015, T24/2016)
- Named the recipient of the PGA TOUR's Courage Award in November

Additional Player Notes

- In tournament debut, Akshay Bhatia (2nd/-20) posts second-best low 54-hole score on the PGA TOUR at 199; seeks second career TOUR title (2023 Barracuda Championship) in 45th career start to become second-youngest winner in tournament history (Tiger Woods/21years, 13 days/La Costa Country Club); is one of seven players in the field not yet eligible for the next two Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational), but will be with a victory
- Winner of The Sentry in 2019, **Xander Schauffele** (T3/-19) trails by two following a third-round 65; seeks eighth career TOUR victory and first since 2022 Genesis Scottish Open
- Winner of The Sentry in 2021 Harris English (T6/-18) posts the low-round of the day (9-under 64), highlighted by playing the final five holes with his personal best birdie-eagle streak on TOUR (B-B-B-E); leads the field this week with three eagles and is the only player in the field with multiple eagles in a round (Nos. 5 and 18 in round three)
- With his 477-yard drive on the par-4 7th hole, **Max Homa** (T17/-15) recorded the longest drive on the PGA TOUR in the ShotLink Era (since 2003)
