Today – Dry conditions can be expected much of the day, although there will be a low threat for isolated shower development this afternoon. Otherwise, the wind forecast at Kapalua remains complex with the potential for a periods of strong east/northeast winds. The forecast will reflect this potential, however if these winds fail to materialize, then erratic winds under 20 mph would occur at times. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05". **Sunrise: 7:04am / Sunset: 5:59pm**

Extended forecast – Intrusions of stronger east/northeast winds will still be possible on Saturday with gusts near 25 mph. By Sunday, the Trade Winds will weaken considerably as a cold front begins to approach the Islands. Winds will be light and could become erratic at the course. A threat for shower development will exist Saturday/Sunday, however coverage will remain isolated, if it occurs at all. The threat for rain and stronger winds will increase on Monday as a cold front arrives
