**Today** – A relatively dry and stable pattern remains in place over the Islands, although a brief/light passing shower could occur this morning. Otherwise, a period of brisk east/northeast winds should redevelop by 10am and continue into the afternoon. Gusts of 25-30 mph are possible. Forecast rainfall: Trace. **Sunrise: 7:04am / Sunset: 5:58pm**

**Extended forecast** – The Trade Wind pattern from the last few days will persist into Saturday. This will allow stronger winds to occasionally brush the NW coast of Maui, including Kapalua. Gusts over 25mph will be possible, especially between 10am-4pm. Winds will then drop considerably on Sunday, possibly remaining under 15 mph. The threat for showers will also increase slightly this weekend as moisture levels tick upwards. While no particular period is favored for rainfall, there is potential for afternoon shower buildups over the higher terrain Saturday and Sunday.
