Today – Dry conditions will persist this morning with a risk for showers/T-storms developing during the afternoon. Conditions appear more favorable for T-storms compared to yesterday, thus activity should become scattered (30-40% chance) in coverage. The highest threat favors 3-7pm. Air temperatures will reach 94F today with heat indices (feels like temperatures) maxing out in-between 96-98F. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25" with localized higher amounts possible in T-storms. **Sunrise: 7:10am / Sunset: 8:04pm**

Extended forecast – Through this weekend, the pattern will remain favorable for scattered showers/T-storms during the afternoon/evening. There is some concern for more widespread T-storm development Sunday as weak front approaches. However, given current uncertainty, T-storm chances will be capped at 40%. Temperatures will remain warm, reaching the lower 90s each day. Light southerly winds will continue but could become northerly by Sunday afternoon as the front passes.
