**Today** — Once again, it will be warm and humid with a mixture of clouds and sun expected much of the day. A slight chance (20-25%) for shower/T-storm development will exist this afternoon/evening, however conditions are much less conductive compared to yesterday. If any development occurs, it favors the 4-8pm timeframe. A high temperatures near 94F is expected with peak heat indices (feels like temperatures) in the 96-98F range. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10", with locally higher amounts possible in a T-storm. **Sunrise: 7:10am / Sunset: 8:03pm**

**Extended forecast** – A weak front will push into northern Georgia tomorrow bringing a more substantial threat for showers/T-storms Sunday afternoon. The forecast will increase shower/T-storms chances to 45% with an additional increase possibly needed with the next forecast update. Temperatures will reach the lower 90s on Sunday with a southwest wind during the morning becoming northwest in the afternoon. A low chance (25%) for afternoon shower/T-storms will exist on Monday, however the higher threat likely sets up over central/southern Georgia.
