Today – Hot and slightly more humid conditions can be expected with temperatures climbing into the middle 90s. Peak heat indices (feels like temperatures) will be 98-100F. The other concern is the potential for shower/T-storm development this afternoon. This activity likely remains sparse in coverage with no more than a 15-20% chance any given hour. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10” with localized higher amounts possible in a T-storm. **Sunrise: 7:09am / Sunset: 8:05pm**

Extended forecast – Limited changes to the forecast with just some minor adjustments to the rain/storm probabilities. Otherwise, the expectation is for isolated to widely scattered showers/T-storms development over north Georgia each afternoon, possibly lasting into the evening. Temperatures will cool slightly moving forward with daytime highs reaching the lower 90s. Light southerly winds should persist through most of the weekend but could become northwesterly Sunday afternoon.
