

## Standout Statistics 2024 FedExCup Playoffs

<b>18<sup>th</sup></b>	Season in the FedExCup era
<b>65 / 38</b>	Total FedExCup Playoff events, won by 38 different winners in the 18 <sup>th</sup> season of the FedExCup
<b>17,796</b>	The total number of rounds played with scores ranging from 59 to 86 in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>320,328</b>	The total number of holes played with scores ranging from 1 to 11 in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>1,250,789</b>	Total strokes in the FedExCup Playoffs since 2007 <i>(-8,607 total score to par)</i>
<b>454</b>	The number of different players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs at least once. These 454 players represent 31 different countries.
<b>97.1%</b>	This season, 97.1% of the players (68 of 70) who qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs have only known the FedExCup compared to 9.0% in the inaugural season (2007).
<b>96.70%</b>	of players to qualify for the TOUR Championship this season have only known the FedExCup era. Adam Scott is the only player.
<b>10</b>	Every player who has finished in the Comcast Business TOUR TOP 10 has qualified for the TOUR Championship since 2009
<b>4</b>	players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs in 17 of the 18 seasons
<b>196</b>	The number of different players who have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs at least 5 times
<b>9</b>	Nine players with 10 or more top-five finishes in the FedExCup Playoffs
<b>6</b>	Six of the last 10 FedExCup Playoffs have seen 20 or more different countries represented
<b>4</b>	Four players have more than two wins in the FedExCup Playoffs (Dustin Johnson/6, Rory McIlroy/6, Tiger Woods/4 & Patrick Cantlay/3)
<b>2</b>	Two players have shot 59 in the FedExCup Playoffs (Jim Furyk, 2013 BMW Championship, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Rd & Scottie Scheffler, 2020 FedEx St. Jude Championship, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Rd)
<b>2</b>	Tiger Woods (2007, 2009) and Rory McIlroy (2016, 2019 & 2022) are the only two players to win multiple FedExCup titles.
